WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS FOR YOUR PET?

- Reduced wound size = less discomfort post-operatively and reduced risk of infection
- Fewer sutures to skin & muscle
- Better visualisation during the procedure = reduced risk of complications
- Faster recovery from the procedure = quicker return to normal activity levels



WHAT IS KEYHOLE SPAY?

Keyhole spay is the use of specialised instruments and a camera to spay a bitch through very small incisions, making the procedure much less invasive.



Did you know?

Laparoscopic techniques have been used in the human field for decades, they are now becoming increasingly popular in the veterinary field due to the clear advantages mentioned.

Is your dog over 25kgs?

At our Meopham Hospital and Sevenoaks Surgery, three small 1cm holes are made in the abdomen and a camera is used to locate the ovaries and uterus.

The ovary is then removed performing an ovariectomy.

A lot of post-operative pain associated with spaying using the traditional technique is due to the handling of the uterus.

Everything remains inside the abdomen using the keyhole technique, greatly reducing pain.

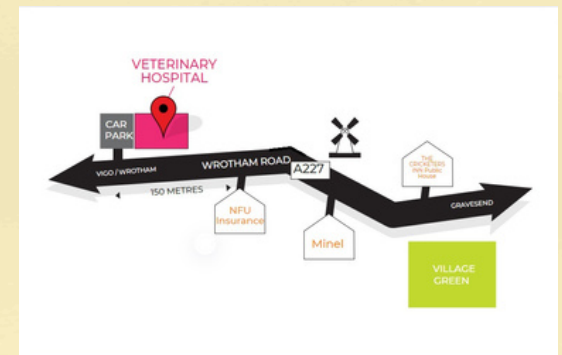
